7. How are you connected with the Norwegian community and what are your interests in Norway's culture?

Information and Suggested Procedure When Completing a

SONS OF NORWAY FOUNDATION IN CANADA

THORSAUG BURSARY APPLICATION

- 1. The application package should include; the completed form, your grade transcript, letter of acceptance and class schedule, resume of yourself (answering questions 1 to 7) and a photograph of yourself.**
- 2. Fill in all the blank spaces on the application form; indicate if *not applicable* to your circumstances. Your Social Insurance Number is required by Revenue Canada for income tax purposes.**
3. It is essential that you include your final grade transcript (of last school attended) and the letter of acceptance to the school or faculty you will be attending and information confirming your scheduled Norwegian classes. Photocopies are acceptable.
4. It is important that you include a color photograph of yourself, suitable for reproduction; this will be used in our District and International magazines if you are a winner. It should be a head and shoulders shot of only you and on **photographic paper**, please do not staple. Photographs will not be returned.
5. In the section entitled “*Also enclose a resume of yourself answering the following*” it is very important that you answer all seven of the requests. Answer giving complete details to all questions, however we ask that you limit your resume to two-thousand (2000) words, excluding a table for your budget which must include BOTH **income and expenses**. The information that you provide is what the ‘*selection committee*’ bases their decisions on.
6. Each request and question carries a numerical value so it is vital that you answer all requests/questions to ensure you will receive the highest marks possible in your bid to receive a bursary.

7. Answering the questions in point form, i.e. 1 to 7, clarifies your answer for the 'selection committee'.
8. The SONS OF NORWAY FOUNDATION IN CANADA Secretary (see address on page two) must receive applications for this bursary by August 31st of each year (**hard copy only, fax and email applications are not accepted**).
9. Only Canadian residents who will be studying in Canada may apply for this bursary.
10. The amount granted for this bursary will be determined annually by the SONS OF NORWAY FOUNDATION IN CANADA. Call Secretary for more details.
11. A student may receive a maximum of three scholarships/bursaries from the SONS OF NORWAY FOUNDATION IN CANADA.
12. If you have applied for a SONS OF NORWAY FOUNDATION IN CANADA scholarship in the past and have not been awarded the maximum number (as in #11 above), you are welcome to apply again.
13. All applicants will be notified as to their standing in the competition, this will generally be sometime in October. If you are the recipient of a bursary the Board of Directors would appreciate an acknowledgement of your receipt of it.
14. This bursary was made possible by a bequest from the late Bjarne Thorshaug, Past President of District #7, Sons of Norway, of Victoria, British Columbia.
